

President Museveni Inspects Moroto Project

On October 27, H.E. Yoweri Kaguta Museveni, President of the Republic of Uganda, accompanied by the First Lady, Hon. Janet Museveni, visited the site of West China Cement's clinker production project in Moroto District to inspect the progress of construction.
